

## AQUALOGY INCREASES ITS PRESENCE IN THE US, IMPLEMENTING ICE PIGGING IN NEW HAMPSHIRE AND MASSACHUSETTS

Aqualogy has reinforced its presence in the US, through Utility Service Group (USG), with the implementation of the Ice Pigging technological solution. In just one week it has sold this service to four new clients which operate in New Hampshire and Massachusetts (US). In particular, it is a question of the companies Town of Wellesley, Dedham-Westwood Water District, Keokuk Municipal Water Works and Town of Wolfeboro Water and Sewer Utilities.

Each of these companies requested the services of Aqualogy after receiving complaints from their clients due to the bad quality of the water. For example, in the case of Town of Wellesley, the water presented an accumulation of sediments and, in the case of Town of Wolfeboro Water and Sewer Utilities, problems related to decolouring and the presence of biofilm.

Ice Pigging is a technological solution adapted to network management which allows water supply tanks and pipes to be maintained and cleaned by injecting ice, with recognized results in Europe, several Latin American countries, Japan and the US. Among other improvements, it achieves a cost saving but, moreover, it prevents episodes of cloudy water and bad flavour. This system is also applied to sewerage networks and irrigation systems.
