

AQUALOGY TO IMPROVE MAIN WATER TANK IN ROCKVILLE (USA)

The facility has a capacity for 8 million gallons (30,000 cubic metres), representing two thirds of the water stored in the city.

This is the second contract to reduce trihalomethanes in water tanks that USG has been awarded, following one in Johnston County (North Carolina).
